Our topics for the Spring Term are 'Taking Flight' and then after half term 'All Aboard!' We begin the term by taking to the skies in our own flight 'experience' to North America and then back in the classroom our journey continues by learning about the famous inventors and aviators The Wright Brothers





In History we will be learning about George Stephenson and will also be experiencing a class train ride and visit to Amberley Museum on Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> March. We are learning to play the recorder in Music lessons with Mr Mott and will be working on ball skills with Mrs Barlow in PE. Our English work this term is focused on poetry and recount (non-fiction) writing. We start by reading, writing and reciting poetry and invite parents and carers to our recital on Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup>

#### Maths

Our focus this term is to really know our number pairs to 10 and 20 and to group objects in 2's, 5's and 10's to count quickly. We will be looking closely at 2D and 3D shape properties while also developing and deepening our knowledge of addition and subtraction.

Our days are now Mondays and Thursdays. Please ensure PE kit is in school and remember to remove jewellery on these days.

### Show and Tell

Continues to be on the first Friday of every month, where the children will be able to bring in one item to show to the class. They could bring in a toy, certificate, photograph, anything they would like to share with us (nothing too precious or very large).

### How can you help?

- Regular reading at home (not just their school book) sharing stories and poems, asking and answering questions about what you have read.
- Supporting homework tasks while letting them develop their independence. We have been so impressed with the effort the children have put into their homework through the Autumn term so please keep it going! The more they do at home, the more confident they can be with their work at school. The homework tasks are also great way of letting you know what we've been learning at school.
- Encourage the children to use their neat joined handwriting when they are writing, especially with their homework.
