Reading, spellings, times tables and learning number facts will continue to be very important aspects of the support you can give your child in their learning.

We will send home the homework books on Fridays, to be returned by Thursday the following week. Homework will vary over the term and will sometimes require your child to have access to a computer/tablet. If this is a problem please see Mrs Reynolds.
