For the party, an army of school staff worked really hard and made and plated about a thousand sandwiches and goodies. Thank you and well done team for getting through that mammoth task.

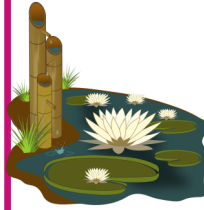
