Online Payments: ParentMail



Our new on-line communication and payment system ParentMail is now in the process of going live. A

few weeks ago, the school office sent out the registration information to all parents and carers in the school. We asked that all families register as soon as possible so that we can make the switch over to ParentMail for all school communication as soon as possible. Having checked the system today, we have noticed that 60 families still haven't registered which means that we cannot fully switch over to the new system. Please can I ask that everyone registers with ParentMail possible as following soon instructions. It takes a few minutes to complete. Whilst Year 6 only have a few weeks left at school, we still need you to register so that we can send you details of any 'leavers' activities that we may plan during the summer holidays. Failure to register could mean that you miss out on receiving important school information when we switch over. Thank you.
